

Ortel brings hourly packages for Bhubaneswar, Cuttack

BHUBANESWAR, Dec. 16. — Ortel Communications Ltd., which had been established with a vision to provide broadband communications to the common man of Orissa and the company's Internet services division Ortel.net, has now introduced hourly package scheme.

The division Ortel.net has been providing Internet services through the cable television network in the twin cities of Bhubaneshwar and Cuttack

Under this new system, the customer will have the flexibility of using as little hours as required by him on the basis of the payment of hourly charges. The two initial packages which are launched now under the name of "Easy Pack" has the following features:

For a 25-hour package, a customer pays Rs 250 and can use the Internet for 25 hours during a month.

For a 50 hours package, the customer pays Rs 500 and uses it for 50 hours during a three-month period.

"With this new system, we will be able to provide our service to each and every section of the Net Users in the market," said Mr BP Rath, the vice-president of Ortel Communications Ltd. "We plan to launch many variations of the package so as to make it more flexible and cost effective for our customers. In this way we hope to increase our number of clients to the maximum," Mr Rath added.
